Red Wines – Italy

Piedmonte

- 103 Nebbiolo, “Perbacco,” Vietti** 58⁰⁰
Loads of tanned leather and tea, with ripe berry and plum aromas. Full-bodied with a chocolate and coffee bean aftertaste.
- 109 Barbera, Bricotondo, Fontanafredda** 36⁰⁰
This is a ruby-red wine with purple highlights. The nose is packed with black fruit, especially blackberries and plums, with slight spicy overtones hinting at black pepper and cinnamon. Sweet, soft tannins come together in a closely-woven texture that combines with great fruit character and crisp freshness on the palate.
- 102 Barolo, “Albe,” G.D. Vajra 2017** 85⁰⁰
Albe is the blend of high elevation Barolo DOCG vineyards. Opens up with a bright, expressive nose. Red currant, cherries, macerated strawberries and mint are interlaced with floral tones and hints of rosehip, rhubarb, red fig, hawthorn, lavender and licorice. The palate is generous, layered, and youthful, with ripe tannins and a classic finish on tones of marasca cherry.
- 100 Barolo, “Serralunga d’Alba,” Fontanafredda** 98⁰⁰
Ruby red color with garnet reflections. The aromas are sharp and intense with hints of vanilla spices, withered roses, and underbrush. The taste is dry but soft, full, velvety, harmonious, and long-lasting.
- 101 Barolo, Prunotto 2012** 120⁰⁰
Smooth and silky expression that offers a genuine level of simplicity and pureness that sets this wine apart. The wine's intensity is mild, but it offers elegantly understated tones of wild berry, ash, licorice and pressed rose petal. The finish is silky and tight

Toscana

- 127 Chianti Classico Riserva, Castello di Querceto** 48⁰⁰
This wine emerges from the glass with big, generous fruit supported by the firm tannins of the vintage. Black cherries, plums, smoke, and licorice wrap around the plush finish.
- 115 Chianti Classico Riserva, Nozzole** 68⁰⁰
Ripe and silky, this wine is rich and aromatic on the nose with sour cherries, light hazelnuts and dried fruit. Full-bodied and very rich with lots of fruit and layers of chewy tannins. Flavorful, juicy finish.
- 117 Chianti Classico Gran Selezione, “Badia a Passignano,” Antinori** 98⁰⁰
This single-vineyard selection's nose presents intense notes of ripe red fruit that merge with sweet hints of blueberries, blackberries, apricots, and violet. Its bouquet is completed by balsamic sensations and toasted aromas of chocolate, licorice, and vanilla. The palate is rich and flavorful.
- 151 Rosso dei Notri, Tua Rita (Super Tuscan)** 48⁰⁰
Rosso dei Notri is an absolute delight. A fresh and fruity red with aromas of chocolate and dark fruit with hints of blackberries, plums, cherries, and hazelnuts. Medium body, fine tannins with hints of herbs and dark fruit, and a lovely finish harvested from vineyards in the foothills of Suvereto, a small hilltop village in Tuscany.
- 119 Il Bruciato, Bolgheri, Tenuta Guado al Tasso (Super Tuscan)** 62⁰⁰
Intensely ruby red in color, its nose expresses notes of small dark fruit and sweet spices with a well-structured palate; fresh fruity notes dominate the finish giving the wine a lush, sweet character. The tannins are plush and soft with a supple mouthfeel that gives this wine its exceedingly easy-drinking personality.
- 129 Grattamaco, Bolgheri (Super Tuscan)** 78⁰⁰
The nose is a combo of dark fruits and chocolate with notes of plum and black currants, elegant and full with a fresh balsamic finish given by the Sangiovese. A dense and powerful wine with ripe tannins, juicy and rich with a striking structure.
- 123 Ca’marcanda Promis, Gaja (Super Tuscan)** 98⁰⁰
Rich ruby red in color; on the nose this excellent vintage offers spices, dark, fleshy fruits, cherries, blackberries, and tar. On the palate this wine has firm tannin, wonderful full fruit, persistence, intensity, and depth.

Toscana

- 150 Merlot, “Desiderio,” Avignonese** 105⁰⁰
The wide aromatic bouquet ranges from cherry and plum jam to notes of black tea, rhubarb and graphite, with small final notes of tobacco. The palate is invested by the imposing and typical structure of Tuscan Merlot, enveloping and warm. A soft, fruity red with berry, chocolate, and plum character. Medium-bodied, this wine is vivid and refined for the vintage.
- 120 Guado al Tasso, Bolgheri, Antinori (Super Tuscan)** 225⁰⁰
Its nose is clean and powerful and has hints of small red ripe fruits such as raspberries, wild strawberries, arbutus, wild blackberries and pleasant notes of laurel and mint. Its entry on the palate is soft, voluminous and persistent with a tannic texture that is dense and silky. Remarkable for its extraordinary balance and equilibrium between power and grace.
- 124 Cabernet Sauvignon “Il Sole di Alessandro,” Castello di Querceto** 138⁰⁰
This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon shows Tuscan characteristics of maraschino and dried Mediterranean herb. This is enhanced by notes of chocolate, espresso bean, and cinnamon. The tannins are silky and long.
- 118 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Avignonesi** 59⁰⁰
Aromas of red berries, cherry and pomegranate and the unmistakable violet scent of Sangiovese. On the palate it is well balanced with flavors of ripe cherry, plum, chocolate and walnut supported by a dense tannic texture.
- 125 Brunello di Montalcino, Col d’Orcia** 120⁰⁰
Ruby red with violet hues. Complex and elegant. With red fruity notes like cherry and sour cherry and spicy aromas. Balanced and structured with pleasantly ripe tannins. The finish is long, fruity, and lasting.
- 134 Brunello di Montalcino, Val di Suga 2016** 135⁰⁰
Aromas of fresh button mushrooms. hints of fennel, brushed leather, and black cherry. The palate is dark fruited without weight, marked with dried blackberry, black tea, dried herbs, and classically balanced. Savory mushrooms and olives, followed by a vibrant acid structure that sustains a concentrated mouthfeel, rich in silky tannins. Full-bodied, the finish is extremely long and soft.
- 122 Brunello di Montalcino, Banfi** 137⁰⁰
Deep red with garnet nuances, the nose reveals its complexity with aromas of plum, ripe cherry and small red fruits that perfectly combine with those of licorice and tobacco. In the mouth, it is full-bodied, with pleasant and soft tannins. Intense finish and great persistence

Veneto

- 107 Ripasso Valpolicella Superiore, “Monti Garbi,” Tenuta Sant’Antonio** 40⁰⁰
Blended with the grace of Valpolicella and the power of Amarone, often referred to as “baby Amarone.” On the nose, notes of red fruit and cherry. Medium-to full-bodied and very flavorful. On the palate, it is sweet, soft, enveloping, fresh, savory and quite tannic with a spicy aftertaste.
- 139 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, La Gaietta** 75⁰⁰
At least two years of aging and subsequent refinement in the bottle result in a ruby red wine with flavors of black cherry cobbler and chocolate with a robust body and a particularly well-balanced flavor.
- 141 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Allegrini** 145⁰⁰
A true classic of the appellation, this red wine embraces tradition, territory and the know-how of country ways. The smooth, concentrated palate boasts a weightless elegance, delivering blackberry compote, ripe Morello cherry, licorice and baking spice framed in enveloping, velvety tannins.

Red Wines - Domestic

California

- 181 Cabernet Sauvignon, Arrowood, Sonoma** 50⁰⁰
Dominated by layers of red fruit with aromas of black cherry pie, currants, and hints of clove. Offers generous layered aromas of woodland berries with undertones of caramel and cedar. Round and supple on the palate, its vibrant ripeness shows the best of Sonoma fruit.
- 185 Cabernet Sauvignon, Iconoclast, Napa** 78⁰⁰
Artisanally crafted with bold, bright dark fruit flavors and hints of baking spice from 20 months of French oak aging. The wine expresses a lush texture with a long, smooth finish. This wine epitomizes Napa Cabernet.
- 182 Cabernet Sauvignon, Charles Krug, Napa** 67⁰⁰
Ripe black cherry, blackberry, and black currant flavors precede hints of dried blueberry and cocoa this estate grown and bottled Cabernet Sauvignon from our Yountville vineyards. The sturdy structure of black fruits lend definition to the long finish.
- 155 Symmetry, Meritage, Rodney Strong, Alexander Valley** 95⁰⁰
Symmetry is a luxurious bouquet of black cherry, plum, black fig, and rose petals which unfold on the palate with silky layers of black fruits, minerality, and baking spices.
- 179 Pinot Noir, Daou Vineyards, Central Coast** 57⁰⁰
Enticing aromas of cherry, rhubarb and rose petal, with notes of African violet, cloves and toasty oak. Silky and lush on the palate, with rich flavors of ripe strawberry, cherry and black raspberries. Subtle hints of black olive and truffle.
- 190 Pinot Noir, Talbott, "Sleepy Hollow," Estate Grown, Santa Lucia Highlands 2016** 82⁰⁰
Fresh aromas of cola, black cherry and blackberry along with richer notes of vanilla and subtle spices. On the rich palate, savory notes of black cherry, vanilla, clove and nutmeg meld with raspberry and plum flavors for a soft, mouth-filling texture. Has vibrant acidity to complement a satiny smooth finish with a delightful touch of well-heeled tannins, cinnamon, vanilla and hard spices.

Pacific Northwest

- 192 Pinot Noir, WillaKenzie Estate, Willamette Valley, OR 2018** 72⁰⁰
Captures the best of Willamette Valley, with a layered structure that's crisp yet supple with plump raspberry, orange peel and Darjeeling accents that glide toward refined tannins. Effortless, yet weighty.
- 199 Cabernet Sauvignon, Col Solare, Red Mountain, WA** 135⁰⁰
Aromas of black cherry, currants, cinnamon, and rose petals with gorgeous notes of crème de cassis, toasted spices, white flowers, and subtle oak all emerge from this super-rich, full-bodied Cabernet that stays perfectly balanced and elegant. Tannins are rich and refined on the finish, a characteristic of Red Mountain fruit.

Red Wines From Around the World

Argentina

- 601 Malbec, Catena, Mendoza** 45⁰⁰
Deep aromas of ripe red and dark fruits are joined by delicate violet and lavender notes, with traces of vanilla and mocha. A rich, concentrated mouthfeel is highlighted by flavors of blueberries and blackberries with a touch of leather and cinnamon.

White Wines - Italy

Alto-Adige

- 239 **Pinot Grigio, “Castel Ringberg,” Elena Walch Estate Vineyard** 57⁰⁰
A complex variety of fruits, especially ripe pears and lime blossom, as well as spicy sage notes inform the bouquet. Structure and elegance, power and harmony dominate the palate, combined with creamy fullness and density. A single vineyard Pinot Grigio with a lot of character

Veneto

- 270 **Soave Classico, “Monte Carbonare,” Suavia** 65⁰⁰
100% Garganega, this wine is a pure expression of its volcanic terroir. This wine is creamy and elegant with bright freshness and aromas of citrus, herbs, and mineral. On the palate the wine is well-balanced and refreshing with a dry and persistent finish.

Umbria

- 243 **Cervaro della Sala, Antinori** 110⁰⁰
Cervaro is arguably the best white wine from Italy. A blend of Chardonnay and Grechetto, this wine is big and powerful, without being ripe and heavy. Full-bodied, the nose offers perceptible notes of chamomile and flint. The palate is savory with the characteristic and delicate sensations of vanilla which meld gracefully into hints of tropical fruit to compose a well-defined bouquet. This wine is fresh and spicy with stone fruit, mature apricot, honey, saffron and toasted almond.

Campania

- 238 **Fiano di Avellino, Mastroberardino** 48⁰⁰
This is a delicate wine with hints of fresh fruit, almond, hazelnut, citrus fruits, herbs, white flowers, and dried flowers. On the palate, this is a full-bodied wine with light fruit and floral notes.

White Wines

California

- 277 **Chardonnay, “Katherine’s Vineyard,” Cambria, Santa Barbara** 38⁰⁰
Ocean influenced, single vineyard expression of “refrigerated sunshine” in a glass – layered, elegant, distinct. Pink grapefruit, tangerine, citrus blossom, and apple flavors are complemented by a bit of wet stone.
- 278 **Chardonnay, “Dutton Ranch,” Patz & Hall, Russian River Valley** 105⁰⁰
Lovely and inviting, this wine is crisp and well-crafted with a zip of minerality. Aromas of ginger, guava and Crème brûlée with toasted almond, and toffee-brown sugar. Green apple note on the palate melds with dried apricot, tangerine flavors along with a hint of toasted oak. The wine finishes dry with fresh acidity and a touch of lemon zest and candied ginger.
- 274 **Chardonnay, “Four Hearts Vineyard,” Hartford Court, Russian River Valley** 88⁰⁰
This highly textured wine displays aromas of yellow apple, honeysuckle and tangerine skin. Fresh flavors of Granny Smith apple and Meyer lemon are intertwined with layers of spice and crystallized ginger. A rich and weighty mid-palate is followed by a very long exotic, mineral-infused finish.

273 Chardonnay, Jordan, Russian River Valley **75⁰⁰**
A vintage defined by its crispness, vibrancy and freshness. Pretty aromas of honeysuckle, lemon blossom and Fuji apple spring from the glass. The palate boasts bright, lively layers of citrus with a hint of oak and creaminess from careful barrel aging and bâtonnage. Flavors of kumquat, lemon and Fuji apple linger in the juicy, mouthwatering finish.

271 Fumé Blanc, Ferrari-Carano, Sonoma **40⁰⁰**
Delicious aromas and flavors of grapefruit, peach, melon, lychee, lemon grass, lime zest, lemon chiffon and floral notes with a hint of minerality. Bright acidity and crisp freshness from the cool, stainless steel tank fermentation, while the subtle oak character from neutral French oak barrels adds body, complexity and depth.

Rosé Wines

Provence

402 Cape Bleue Rosé, Jean-Luc Colombo, Méditerranée **32⁰⁰**
Pronounced raspberry aromas over a core of red fruit, classic watermelon and peach notes. An elegant mouthfeel, fluid and round with ample length and crisp finish.

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Red – By The Glass

Chianti Classico Riserva, Castello di Querceto \$12

This wine emerges from the glass with big, generous fruit supported by the firm tannins of the vintage. Black cherries, plums, smoke, and licorice wrap around the plush finish.

Barbera, Briccotondo, Fontanafredda \$13

Blackberries and plums on the nose, with slight spicy overtones of black pepper and cinnamon. Sweet, soft tannins in a closely woven texture. Medium-bodied with fresh acidity and a clean finish.

Pinot Noir, Acrobat, Oregon \$13

Rich, fruit-forward aromas of bright Bing cherry and raspberries, with hints of cinnamon and baking spices. The palate echoes with ripe strawberries and dark chocolate up front, followed by earthy and spicy notes of forest floor and clove with fine-grained tannins and refreshing acidity.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Wentz Vineyards, Livermore Valley \$11

This wine welcomes you with aromatics of warm baking spices. On the palate this wine delivers ripe blackberry and fig with round, smooth tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Arrowood, Sonoma \$16

Dominated by layers of red fruit with aromas of black cherry pie, currants, and hints of clove. Offers generous layered aromas of woodland berries with undertones of caramel and cedar. Round and supple on the palate, its vibrant ripeness shows the best of Sonoma fruit.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Iconoclast, Napa \$22

Artisanally crafted with bold, bright dark fruit flavors and hints of baking spice from 20 months of French oak aging. The wine expresses a lush texture with a long, smooth finish. This win epitomizes Napa Cabernet.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Turnbull Estate Grown, Napa \$30

Notes of dusted blackberries, plum, and cherry lead to a back-drift of toast and fleeting tobacco. Supple creamy tannins widen the dark fruit midpalate, lending to a lifted and layered finish.



Tenuta di Arceno, “Valadorna,” Super Tuscan 2015 \$36

Dark and thickly endowed red wine that boasts a rich and lasting grip on the palate. Offers depth and complexity with dark fruit, leather, cured tobacco and spice with softer notes of chocolate and ground espresso beans. The wine's seamless integration of flavors leads to increased momentum and intensity as the wine continues to open in the glass.



White & Rosé – By The Glass

Pinot Grigio, Santa Cristina, Antinori, Venezia \$11

Straw yellow in color. The nose is delicate yet intense with aromas of bananas and citrus fruits. Its palate is well balanced, light and soft.

Chardonnay, Tormaresca, Antinori, Puglia \$11

On the nose, dominant notes of white pulp fruit, apples, and pineapples are well balanced by citrusy sensations of orange blossoms and jasmine. Its fragrant palate is savory with a soft entry and balanced freshness.

Chardonnay, “Four Hearts Vineyard,” Hartford Court, Russian River Valley \$17

This highly textured wine displays aromas of yellow apple, honeysuckle and tangerine skin. Fresh flavors of Granny Smith apple and Meyer lemon are intertwined with layers of spice and crystallized ginger. A rich and weighty mid-palate is followed by a very long exotic, mineral-infused finish.

Riesling, Dr. Loosen, “Dr. L,” Mosel, Germany \$11

A bright, refreshing, fruit-driven wine, with a juicy mid-palate and a crisp, drying finish.

Fumé Blanc, Ferrari-Carano, Sonoma \$12

This wine has delicious aromas and flavors of grapefruit, peach, melon, lychee, lemon grass, lime zest, lemon chiffon and floral notes with a hint of minerality. The Fumé Blanc has bright acidity and crisp freshness.

Cape Bleue Rosé, Jean-Luc Colombo, Provence \$11

Pronounced raspberry aromas over a core of red fruit, classic watermelon and peach notes.
